

Mother Dairy ensures smooth supply of milk

PUNE: Mother Dairy, a wholly-owned subsidiary of National Dairy Development Board, contributed in stabilising the dairy supply chain in Vidarbha and Marathwada region amid the lockdown.

Since the outbreak of COVID-19 in the region, the dairy did not cease its procurement operations for even a single day. Instead, it has increased its milk inflow by 16 per cent despite these testing times and lean season. Interestingly, in the last two months, the dairy was able

to procure benefits to the tune of around Rs 65 crore which were paid to the farmers," said a press release by Ministry of fisheries, Animal husbandry and dairying.

Mother Dairy is extending all possible support to farmers and procuring an average milk volume of 2.55 lakh litres per day in Vidarbha and Marathwada region. The dairy has also made requisite arrangements of balanced cattle feed and feed supplements to the milk producers.
